
IGNITION SWITCH

COMPONENTS



REMOVAL

1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN COVER
 - (a) Remove the 3 screws, cover lower and upper. HINT:

Turn the steering wheel to the right and left as necessary to remove the 3 screws and cover lower.

3. DISCONNECT CONNECTOR

(a) Disconnect the 2 connectors and wire harness clamps from the steering column.

- REMOVE STEERING COLUMN UPPER WITH SWITCH BRACKET ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Using a centering punch, mark the center of the 2 tapered-head bolts.
 - (b) Using a 3 to 4 mm (0.12 to 0.16 in.) drill, drill a hole in the 2 bolt heads.
 - (c) Using a screw extractor, remove the 2 bolts, clamp and steering column upper with switch bracket.

5. REMOVE IGNITION SWITCH ASSEMBLY

(a) Remove the 2 screws and switch from the steering column bracket.
