TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

HINT:

This inspection procedure is a simple troubleshooting procedure. It should be carried out on the vehicle during system operation and was prepared on the assumption of system component troubles (except for the wires and connectors, etc.).

Troubleshooting considerations:

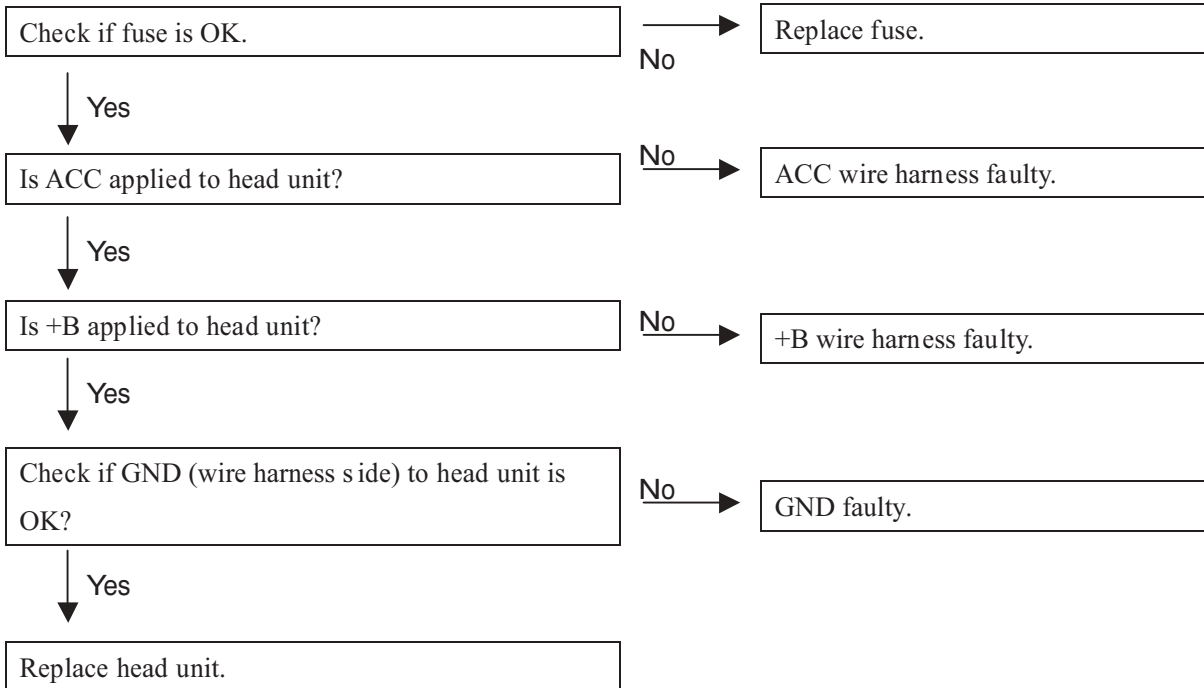
- *Open or short circuit of the wire harness
- *Faulty connector or terminal connection

CARE OF REPLACEMENT PART

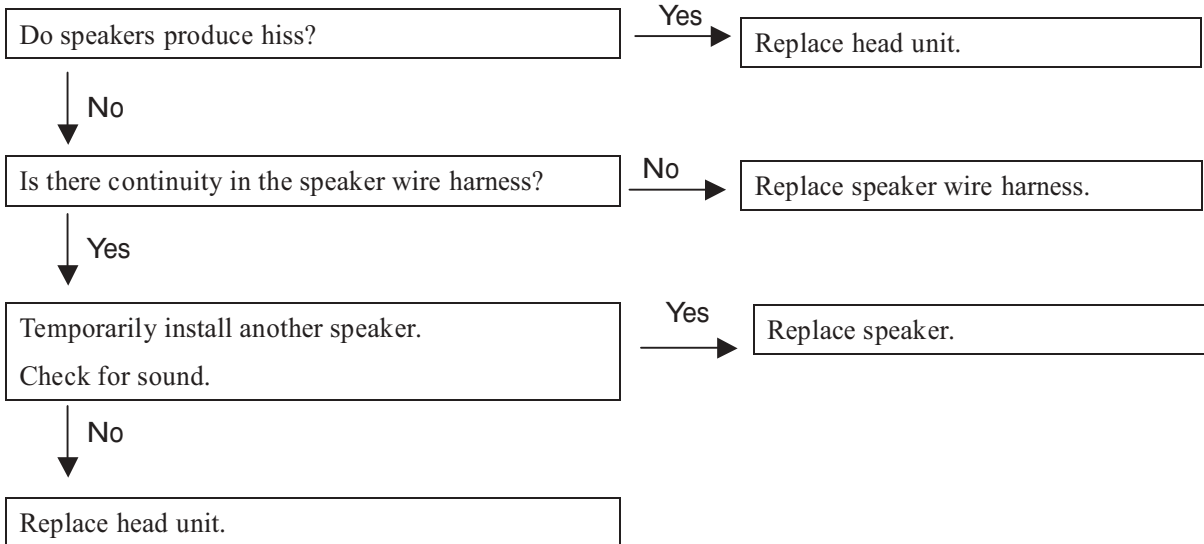
When replacing the internal mechanism of the audio system, be careful that no part of your body or clothing comes in contact with the terminals or the leads from any replacement parts.

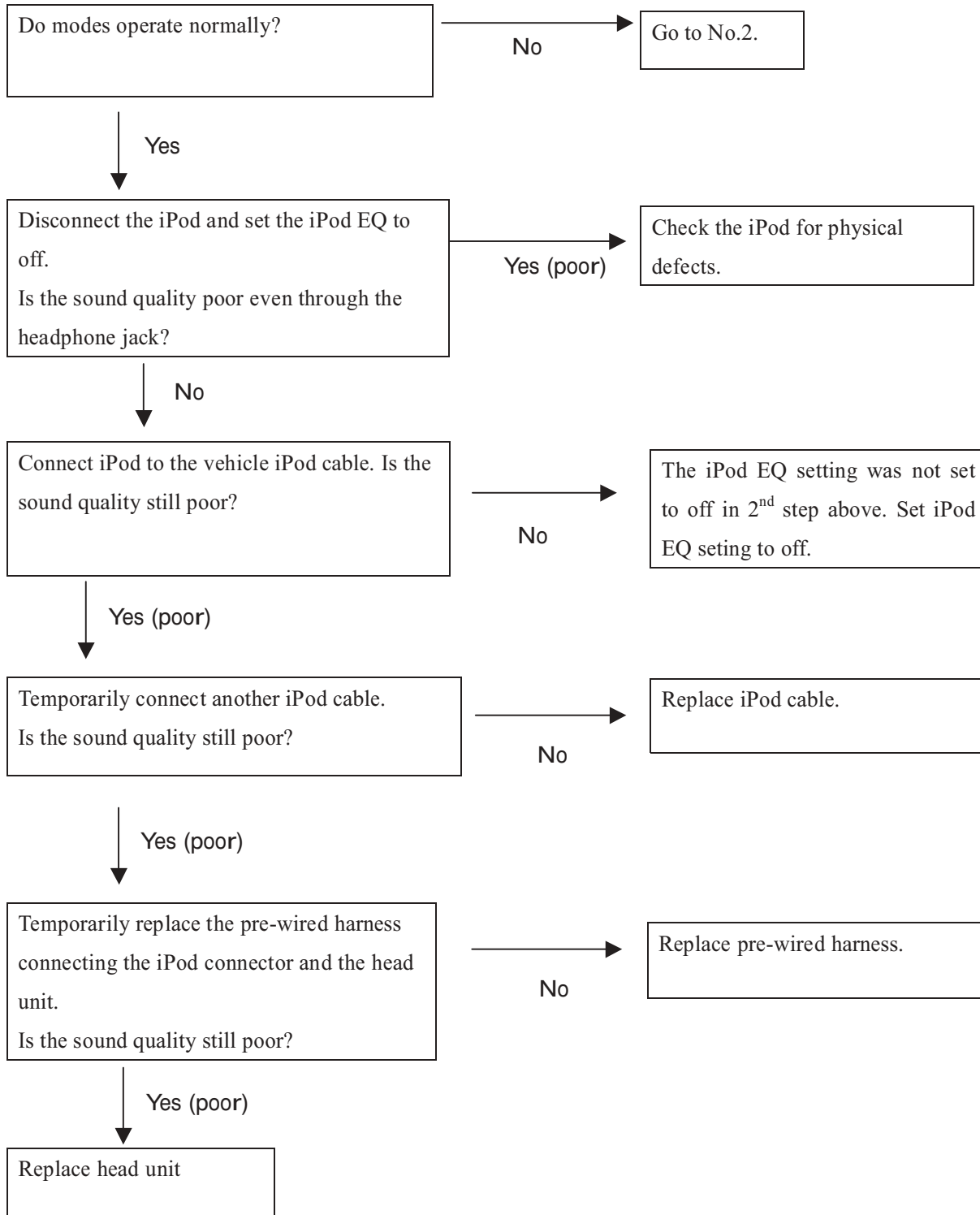

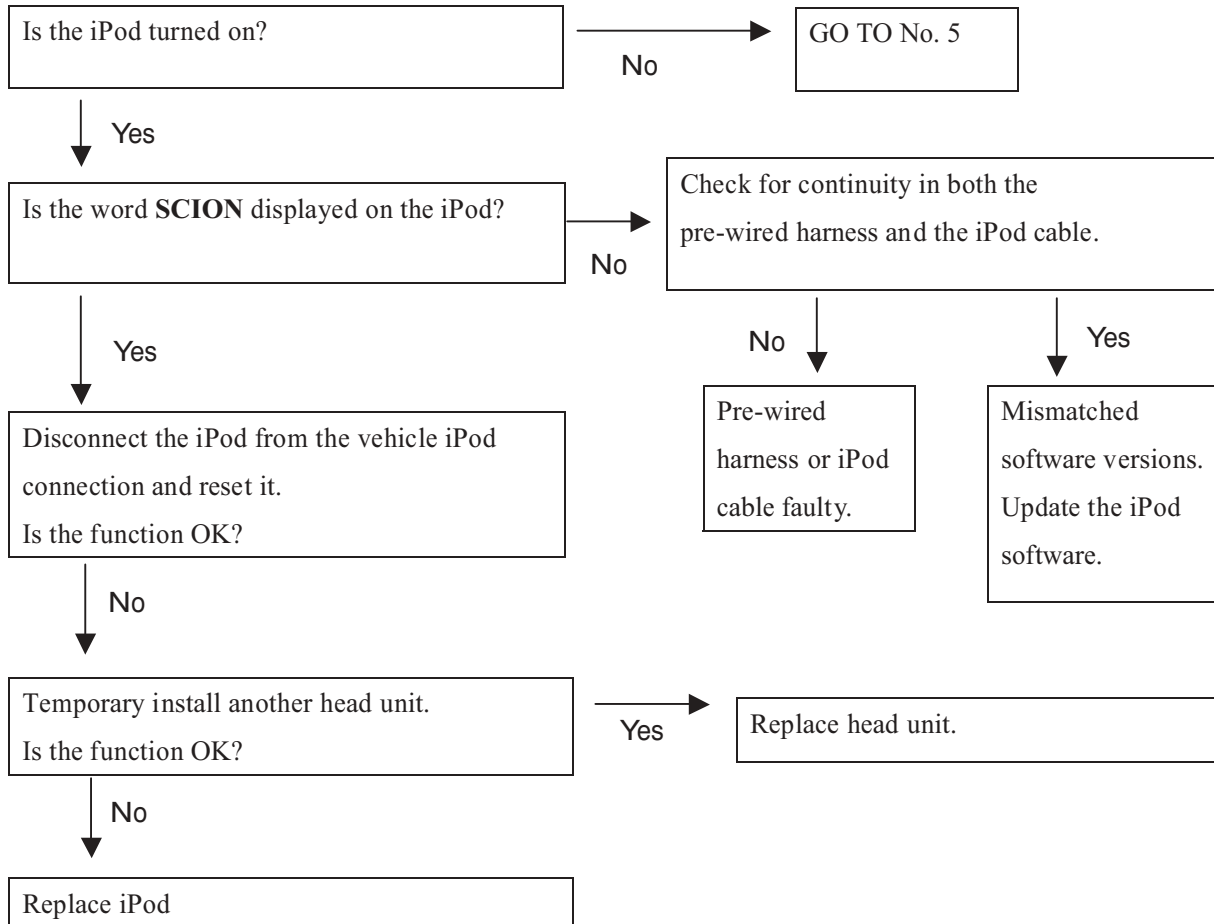
