
HINT:

- Use the same procedures for the RH side and LH side.
- The procedures listed below are for the LH side.
- 1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL


CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE RH (See page IR-6)
- 3. REMOVE REAR DOOR SCUFF PLATE LH (See page IR-6)
- 4. REMOVE REAR DOOR OPENING TRIM RH
- 5. REMOVE REAR DOOR OPENING TRIM LH
- 6. REMOVE REAR SEAT ASSEMBLY(a) Rear seat assembly (see page SE-12).
- 7. REMOVE BACK DOOR WEATHERSTRIP
- 8. REMOVE SPARE WHEEL COVER ASSEMBLY
- 9. REMOVE DECK TRIM COVER REAR (See page IR-7)
- 10. REMOVE REAR SPEAKER ASSEMBLY LH
 - (a) Disconnect the connector.
 - (b) Remove the 3 bolts and speaker.
