

- 2. DRAIN BRAKE FLUID NOTICE: Wash off brake fluid imi


Wash off brake fluid immediately if it comes in contact with any painted surface.


- 3. REMOVE FRONT DISC BRAKE CYLINDER SUB-ASSEMBLY LH
 - (a) Remove the union bolt and gasket from the front disc brake cylinder, and then disconnect the flexible hose.
 - (b) Hold the brake cylinder slide pin, and remove the 2 bolts and brake cylinder.
- 4. REMOVE FRONT DISC BRAKE PAD
 - (a) Remove the 2 pads with anti squeal shims.
- 5. REMOVE FRONT ANTI SQUEAL SHIM
 - (a) Remove the No. 1 and No. 2 shims from each pad.
- 6. REMOVE FRONT DISC BRAKE PAD SUPPORT PLATE
 - (a) Remove the 2 support plates from the cylinder mounting.




