
ON-VEHICLE INSPECTION

- 1. INSPECT BACK DOOR PANEL SUB-ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Check that the clearance measurements of areas A to F are within the standard range.



Standard measurement

Area	Specified Condition
Α	7.5 +- 1.5 mm (0.300 +- 0.059 in.)
В	1.0 +- 1.5 mm (0.040 +- 0.059 in.)
С	5.5 +- 1.5 mm (0.228 +- 0.059 in.)
D	2.7 +- 1.5 mm (0.106 +- 0.059 in.)
E	6.0 +- 1.5 mm (0.236 +- 0.059 in.)
F	7.2 +- 1.5 mm (0.283 +- 0.059 in.)



DISASSEMBLY

1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE BACK DOOR TRIM BOARD
 - (a) Using a clip remover, remove the 11 clips and trim board.
- 3. REMOVE BACK DOOR GARNISH OUTSIDE (See page ET-24)
- 4. REMOVE CENTER STOP LIGHT ASSEMBLY (See page LI-20)
- REMOVE REAR WIPER MOTOR ASSEMBLY (See page WW-16)



- (a) Disconnect the door lock connector.
- (b) Remove the 3 bolts and door lock. HINT:

Remove the door lock through the service hole.



- (a) Using a clip remover, remove the 2 clips.
- (b) Using a heat light, heat the channel.

Standard heating temperature: 20 to 30°C (68 to 86°F)

NOTICE:

Do not heat the body and channel excessively.

(c) Using a screwdriver, remove the channel. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.



(a) Use the same procedures described for the LH side.

9. REMOVE DOOR PULL HANDLE

(a) Using a screwdriver, detach the 4 claws and remove the pull handle.

HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.

- 10. REMOVE BACK DOOR STAY SUB-ASSEMBLY LH (See page ED-42)
- 11. REMOVE BACK DOOR STAY SUB-ASSEMBLY RH
 - (a) Use the same procedures described for the LH side.
- 12. REMOVE BACK DOOR STOPPER LOWER
 - (a) Remove the bolt and stopper LH and RH.
