

MANUAL TRANSAXLE OIL

ON-VEHICLE INSPECTION

- 1. INSPECT TRANSAXLE OIL
 - (a) Stop the vehicle on a level surface.
 - (b) Remove the filler plug and gasket.
 - (c) Check that the oil level is between 0 to 5 mm (0 to 0.20 in.) from the bottom lip of the filler plug opening.

If the result is not as specified, add transaxle oil. **Oil grade:**

API GL-4 or GL-5

Viscosity:

SAE 75W- 90

Standard capacity:

1.9 liters (2.0 US qts, 1.7 lmp. qts) NOTICE:

- Too much or too little oil will lead to transaxle problems.
- After adjusting the oil level, drive the vehicle and check the oil level again.
- (d) Check for oil leakage when the oil level is low.
 If leakage is found, repair the area necessary to stop the leak. Replace damaged parts as necessary.
- (e) Install a new gasket and the filler plug. Torque: 39 N*m (400 kgf*cm, 29 ft.*lbf)
