

REMOVAL


1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL CAUTION:


Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.


2. REMOVE INSTRUMENT CLUSTER FINISH PANEL

- (a) Remove the clip.
- (b) Using a screwdriver, detach the 7 claws and 2 clips, and remove the instrument cluster finish panel. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.







3. REMOVE COMBINATION METER ASSEMBLY

- (a) Remove the 3 screws.
- (b) Disconnect the connector, and remove the combination meter.

DISASSEMBLY

1. REMOVE COMBINATION METER GLASS

(a) Using a screwdriver, detach the 3 claws and remove the combination meter glass. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.

2. REMOVE NO. 1 COMBINATION METER COVER

 (a) Using a screwdriver, detach the 6 claws and remove the combination meter cover. HINT:

Tape the screwdriver tip before use.
