

1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL CAUTION:


Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE INSTRUMENT PANEL FINISH PANEL LOWER CENTER (See page IP-19)
- 3. REMOVE CENTER AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Disconnect the airbag sensor connectors.
 - (b) Using a T40 "torx" socket, remove the 4 screws and airbag sensor.

INSTALLATION

CAUTION:

Be sure to read the precautionary notices concerning the SRS airbag system before servicing it (see page RS-1).

- 1. INSTALL CENTER AIRBAG SENSOR ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Using a T40 "torx" socket, install the airbag sensor with the 4 screws.

Torque: 20 N*m (200 kgf*cm, 14 ft.*lbf) CAUTION:

- If the airbag sensor has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case, bracket or connector, replace it with a new one.
- When installing the airbag sensor, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- (b) Connect the airbag sensor connectors.
- 2. INSTALL INSTRUMENT PANEL FINISH PANEL LOWER CENTER (See page IP-26)
- 3. CONNECT CABLE TO NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 4. CHECK SRS WARNING LIGHT
 - (a) Check the SRS warning light (see page RS-18).
