
1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

- 2. REMOVE FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Remove the front seat assembly (see page SE-3).

3. REMOVE SEAT POSITION AIRBAG SENSOR

- (a) Disconnect the connector.
- (b) Using a T30 "torx" socket, remove the screw and seat position sensor.

. INSTALL SEAT POSITION AIRBAG SENSOR

- (a) Connect the connector.
- (b) Install the sensor.
- Using a T30 "torx" socket, install the screw.
 Torque: 8.0 N*m (82 kgf*cm, 71 in.*lbf)
 CAUTION:
 - If the sensor has been dropped, or there are any cracks, dents or other defects in the case or connector, replace the sensor with a new one.
 - When installing the sensor, be careful that the SRS wiring does not interfere with other parts and that it is not pinched between other parts.
- 2. INSTALL FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY
 - (a) Install the front seat assembly (see page SE-8).
- 3. CONNECT CABLE TO NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 4. CHECK SRS WARNING LIGHT
 - (a) Check the SRS warning light (see page RS-18).
